**Regional priorities.** We advocate for regional priorities identified by the Partnership.



Tier 3	\$25,000-\$100,000	Large companies/ industry/coal terminals, port authority
Government	\$10,000-\$260,000	All tiers of government
Community	\$50-\$1,000	Traditional Owner, community and conservation groups
