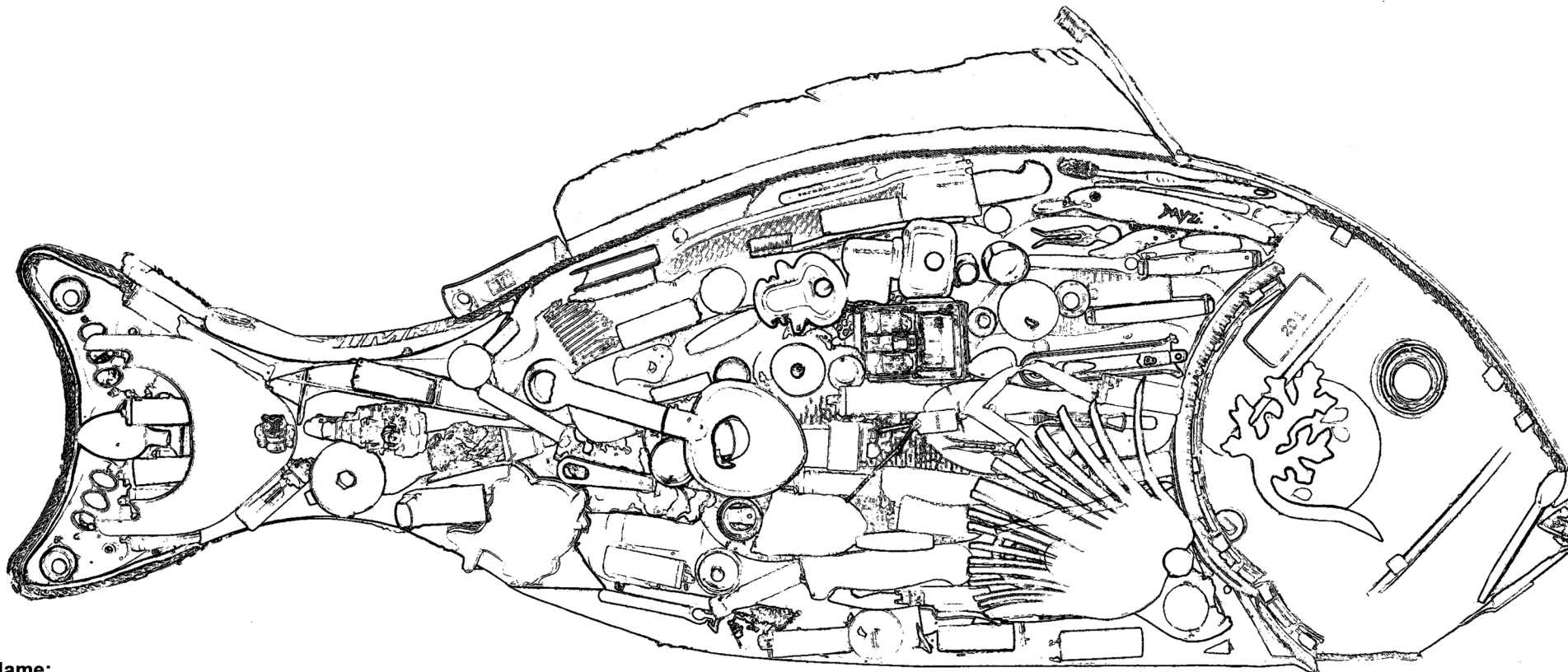

### DID YOU KNOW?

- Joe is made from litter collected from beaches in Mackay and the Whitsundays – 25kg to be exact!
- Parrotfish are real! They have about 1,000 teeth cemented together in rows to form a parrot-like beak.
- Parrotfish are known as 'the cleaners of the sea' as they eat the algae off coral.
- Litter that isn't put in the bin can make its way into the sea by wind and rainwater.
- Fish, seabirds, turtles and marine mammals can get caught in the litter and sometimes confuse it for food – This can make them very sick!
- You can help fish and other sea creatures by **always putting your rubbish in the bin and taking your belongings with you when you leave the beach and your campsite!**
